Both men's destinies are intertwined. Bolo Yeung (*Enter the Dragon*) showcases his mammoth forearms and triceps frequently! This is followed by ***Black Belt (1973)***. Granted, it might be educational for kids to see the lion tamer gratuitously slapping his girlfriend around or a teenage girl apparently giving an ape hand-relief (we didn't believe it at first either), we don't know if we'd be prepared to field Junior's many questions about the unsavory goings-on in the cheapest, most depraved carnival this side of Tod Browning's FREAKS.
