In *Rock ‘N’ Roll High School (1979)* a group of rock-music-loving students, with the help of the Ramones, take over their school to combat its newly installed oppressive administration. Featuring a wonderful cast (including Clint Howard, Paul Bartel, and Vincent Van Patten) and great one-liners (Joey Ramone: "Things sure have changed since we got kicked out of high school"), *Rock 'n' Roll High School* eschews anything resembling "reality." Graduating from high school has never been so deadly... *Graduation Day (1981)* After a high school track runner, named Laura, suddenly dies from a heart attack after finishing a 30-second 100-meter race, a killer wearing a sweat suit and a fencing mask begins killing off her friends on the school track team one by one.

Zombie (1979) Directed by the Italian Godfather of Gore, Lucio Fulci this classic Zombie film follows a young woman's search for her father who is missing since he made an expedition to the Antilles. Featuring the infamous Zombie vs. Shark underwater scene it's a fan favorite amongst those with a fondness for flesh-eaters. *Strange Behavior (1981)* in a sleepy American town a couple of extremely violent murders take place. When the forensic evidence bafflingly points to each separate murder having a different perpetrator, Sheriff Brady thinks these events may be linked to the death of his wife years earlier. Australian produced and shot in New Zealand *Strange Behavior* is a rare and guilty pleasure for horror fans.
