**Grindhouse Redux goddess wears heart on sleeve during  
holiday hack-a-thon, fiery flight attendant double-header**

It's February and love is in the air. Also axes, dismembered limbs, blood-splattered Whitman's Sampler boxes and not a few flaming "coffee, tea or me" vixens! Welcome to Grindhouse Redux, the (belated) Valentine's Day edition.

The Midnite Movie Mamacita--the Valley's own Diva of Desperation Double Features--kicks off her love letter to bad cinema with a rare theatrical screening of the original "flat" version of *My Bloody Valentine* (1981). The inspiration for the recent 3D remake, this seasonal slash-a-rama follows a group of teen sweethearts who kiss it goodbye during a Valentine's Day party . . . unwittingly chaperoned by a homicidal maniac. . . who may or may not be the same killjoy who disemboweled some folks twenty earlier. . . sending their guts to authorities in heart-shaped candy boxes! How deep is their love? Plenty—much of the massacre occurs in a subterranean coal shaft that doubles as the local Tunnel of Love. (Can you say "Be Mine"?) Next, feel free to unbuckle your seatbelts. . . but please resist the urge to hurl from your seats as we unspool **Blazing Stewardesses** (aka *Cathouse Callgirls*) (1975). Despite a title suggesting a cross between a certain Mel Brooks comedy and flight attendants suffering from spontaneous human combustion, this unholy mess from Grade Z director Al (*Girls for Rent*) Adamson is actually "something" about a bunch of grounded stews who wind up a Wild West whorehouse overrun by Yvonne "Lily Munster" DeCarlo, biker movie stalwart Regina Carrol, former B cowboy star Don "Red" Barry, the surviving members of the Thirties comedy team The Ritz Brothers, an inflatable sex doll . . . and a lot of other people you never heard of, either. *Fun fact: Originally envisioned as an R-rated comeback for The Three Stooges--but Moe had the good sense to die before filming began.*
